In response to the request made by our comrades in the Czech Republic, KSM, CYM in Dublin, Ireland, organised a picket outside the Department of Foreign Affairs and delivered a letter of protest to both the department and the Czech Embassy. The Connolly Youth Movement will continue to raise awareness of the anti-democratic measures taken by the Czech government against the KSM in the media and in the general Irish population.

The CYM understands these recent events as part of a global assault upon workers' movements and ideologies and, in our locations in particular, being pushed by the European Union. The defeat of the Lisbon Treaty in Ireland will stand as an important step towards stopping these attacks and towards the building of progressive movements and alliances for social change.
